Tire Collection

Tire collection will be held on Thursday, September 24th from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM at the Liberty Town Hall. Each household is limited to 6 tires. All tires **must be** automotive tires and cannot be larger than 18". Tires and tires on metal rims only **will** be accepted (NO wooden rims). Please mark your calendar, as we will not be advertising this in the local newspaper. Collection is for Town of Liberty residents **only!**

Recycling

Outagamie County is encouraging all Towns within the County to purchase the specialized containers for recyclables. Each container costs approximately \$50 each. The cost will be passed on to Town of Liberty residents. The rationale behind the special containers is ease of handling by the refuse haulers. The driver does not have to leave the vehicle to pick-up the recyclables resulting in a considerable cost savings. The Town Board will discuss options in the near future. Watch the Monthly Town Meeting Agendas that are posted for more information, an opportunity to attend the meeting and present your opinions/ideas related to costs. Paper, plastic, cans and cardboard can all be placed in the same container for pickup biweekly. For other recycling issues, visit the Outagamie County Website at www.outagamie.org. Recycling of household hazardous waste can be scheduled by calling (920) 832-5277. Drop off for items such as vehicle fluids, batteries, cleaners, solvents and paints is at 1419 Holland Road, Appleton, WI. An appointment is required.

Town Meetings

From the Constable's Corner

A new Constable was elected in April, 2015 to replace Norb Morack. I would like to welcome Levi Lambie to the position of Constable. Levi replaced Norb who has served the Town in various capacities for the past 50 years. Norb began his tenure with the Town right out of high school by maintaining our Town Cemeteries. He also served as Building Inspector for 14 years followed by 14 years as Constable. I speak for The Board in thanking Norb for his years of dedicated service which included many late night calls in inclement weather to serve our residents. We also wish Norb well in his retirement.

Dogs - Tags must be purchased for **all** dogs in the Town. New or replacement tags can be purchased from Beth Ubl, Town Treasurer at 982-0908. A large portion of our stray pets have tags but the owners' have neglected to put them on the animals. Please insure that your pet is wearing its tag at all times. This will eliminate the kennel costs to the owner in the event the constable picks up the pet. You will however still be responsible for all constable costs. In the event we receive a complaint and have to send out our Constable to pick up your dog, the approximate costs due you will be \$100 for the animal shelter plus the Constable costs. The second charge for the same pet will exceed \$200. (Cats will be \$50 and \$100 plus

Constable cost.) Do not allow your dog to run at large, habitually bark or howl.

Raft Permits – Raft Permits are required for all rafts on the Wolf and Embarrass River in the Town of Liberty. Permits can be obtained by contacting Levi Lambie @ 359-1444. All rafts must be removed from the river by October 31, 2015.

Town Roads

Town Cemeteries
