Tire Collection

Tire collection will be held on Thursday, September 22nd from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM at the Liberty Town Hall. Each household is limited to 6 tires. All tires **must be** automotive tires and cannot be larger than 18". Tires and tires on metal rims only **will** be accepted (NO wooden rims). Please mark your calendar, as we will not be advertising this in the local newspaper. Collection is for Town of Liberty residents **only!**

Recycling

As mentioned in our 2015 Newsletter, we have signed an agreement with Outagamie County to purchase a recycling cart for each household. The total cost of each cart is \$50. A grant was approved in the amount of \$7 per cart, leaving a total cost of \$43 per household. The \$43 will be assessed on your 2016 property tax bill. The carts are 90 gallon capacity and will be delivered to the Liberty Town Hall in April, 2017. You will be notified as to when your cart will be available for pickup. The carts must be utilized in order for your recyclable to be picked up. The rationale behind the special containers is ease of handling by the refuse haulers. The driver does not have to leave the vehicle to pick-up the recyclables resulting in a considerable cost savings. Paper, plastic, cans and cardboard can all be placed in the same container for pickup biweekly. For other recycling issues, visit the Outagamie County Website at www.outagamie.org. Recycling of household hazardous waste can be scheduled by calling (920) 832-5277. Drop off for items such as vehicle fluids, batteries, cleaners, solvents and paints is at 1419 Holland Road, Appleton, WI. An appointment is required.

From the Constable's Corner

Dogs - Tags must be purchased for **all** dogs in the Town. New or replacement tags can be purchased from Beth Ubl, Town Treasurer at 982-0908. A large portion of our stray pets have tags but the owners' have neglected to put them on the animals. Please insure that your pet is wearing its tag at all times. Do not allow your dog to run at large, habitually bark or howl.

Raft Permits – Raft Permits are required for all rafts on the Wolf and Embarrass River in the Town of Liberty. Permits can be obtained by contacting Levi Lambie @ 359-1444. All rafts must be removed from the river by October 31, 2016.

Town Roads

We plan to replace a large culvert on Lower Road in 2017. If we are able to obtain a grant from the State of Wisconsin, we plan to resurface House Road in 2018.

Town Cemeteries

The Town operates two cemeteries, Mosquito Hill and Turney Hill. There are many stones in need of repair (loose, broken or unreadable). We have a restoration fund and recently received a generous donation in the

amount of \$2000 from Darlene Jeske Bosin. The Cemetery Association would like to continue the restoration of both locations. We welcome and would appreciate any donations to assist us in maintaining the cemeteries. Also, we do have lots available at both locations.

Town Hall Cleanup

Tom Lambie, Supervisor for Town of Liberty has received a grant from Thrivent Action Team for the cleanup of the Liberty Town Hall property.
